

Action Taken

- The report and commendations were reviewed and discussed by a joint meeting of the Curriculum Committee and the Student Outcomes Assessment Committee.
- The Curriculum Committee invited representatives from the English Department to discuss the Electronic component of ISU's Written, Oral, Visual and Electronic Communications initiative.
- As a result of the discussion with English, three CALS faculty members are working with representatives from English to incorporate three different types of electronic communications activities into three CALS courses, an Animal Science class, a Horticulture class and a Microbiology class. In spring and/or fall semesters 2015, CALS will host faculty development seminars where examples of how to incorporate electronic communications activities into CALS courses will be shared.
