

College of Agriculture Transfer and Articulation Goals

1. Establish policies and provide the guidelines for transfer of course credits offered by departments in the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences from Community Colleges in conjunction with the Office of Admissions.
2. Facilitate the process by which students transfer from other academic institutions into the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences at Iowa State University while, at the same time, being sensitive to departmental desires to determine degree requirements for their respective majors.
3. Assist students, as well as faculty and staff, at other academic institutions in understanding Iowa State University transfer policies and programs at both the College and the Departmental levels.
4. Serve as a point of contact on matters dealing with transfer issues between the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences at Iowa State University and other academic institutions.
5. Collaborate with the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences recruitment committee to recruit transfer students and any other college committee that might have student recruiting responsibilities.
